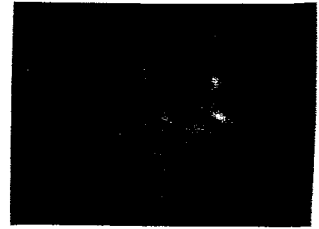

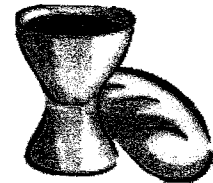

WOMEN'S NEWS

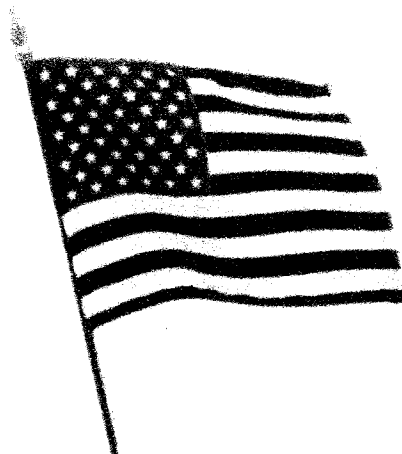

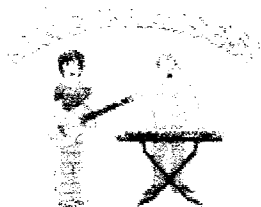
