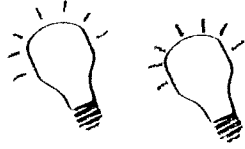
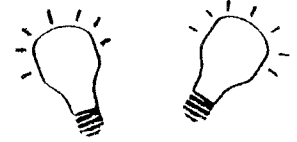

One of the most intriguing and interesting passages of scripture is found in the words of Paul: "FOR WE WALK BY FAITH, NOT BY SIGHT." (II Cor. 5:7) This, of course, seems clear enough, we are to trust God and not demand the evidence of sight in order to accept the truth of the word of God.

It is not as if He said, wait, but rather that in believing and practicing a walk of faith, God will often, perhaps in, a surprising way open our eyes to the fulness of its truth.

To some degree, we find ourselves to to be like the blind man, rejoicing and declaring for all to hear,

"ONE THING I KNOW, THAT THOUGH I WAS BLIND, NOW I SEE"
(John 9:2)

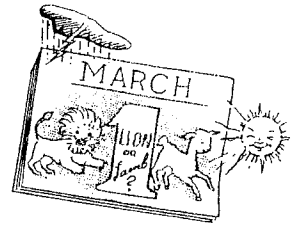
EASTER FLOWERS

WOMEN'S NEWS



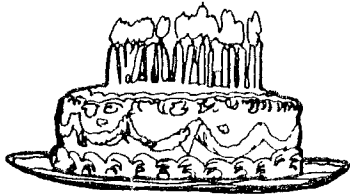
